CSLB Adopts Criteria for Approval of Joint Controls

An addendum which must be incorporated into joint control agreements for any joint control company to be considered approved by the Registrar of Contractors has been adopted by the Contractors State License Roard

The need for criteria constituting Registrar approval of joint control companies was created by 1980 legislation (AB 1363—Lockyer) which amended requirements for home improvement contracts. One of those amendments states that if the contract provides for, and the contractor furnishes, a "...joint control approved by the Registrar of Contractors covering full performance and completion of the contract ...," some previously stated requirements do not apply.

Specifically, there is no limitation on the amount of down payment, and no schedule of payments is required in the contract. These exemptions also apply if the contractor

furnishes a payment and performance bond, lien and completion bond or an equivalent bond covering full performance and completion of the contract.

The Contractors State License Board does not license joint control companies, nor have any legal jurisdiction over their activities. Consequently, after several meetings and much discussion, criteria for "Registrar approval" was developed through mutual agreement of CSLB and joint control company representatives. The resulting addendum (which follows), if included in the control agreement and followed, should prove to be beneficial to both contractors and consumers.

The Board will not maintain lists of approved joint control companies nor monitor their activities. Registrar approval is implicit if the addendum is used. Responsibility for incorporating the

addendum in their agreements, or not, will rest solely with those companies.

ADDENDUM TO CONTROL AGREEMENT/ESCROW INSTRUCTIONS

This addendum is hereby incorporated into and becomes a part of the Control Agreement attached hereto dated ______.

- 1. Should any of the terms or provisions of the contract between Owner and Contractor or of the contract into which this Addendum is incorporated conflict with any of the terms or provisions of this Addendum, then the terms of this Addendum shall prevail.
- 2. Control agrees to control and disburse funds in the following manner:
 - a) Supplier or sub-contractor submits to

LICENSE EXAMS

Authority For Waivers Expanded

Legislation (AB 3067—Lockyer) which became effective January 1, 1983, expanded the circumstances under which the Registrar of Contractors may grant a waiver of examination for contractors license. The law now includes a possible waiver for an immediate member of the family of an individual licensee who has died or is absent.

For purposes of a waiver of examination in such cases "absence" is generally defined as absence from the business due to incapacitating illness. In some cases absence for purposes of this waiver may be allowed for other reasons, but those cases would be unusual.

The family member may apply either for an individual license or as the qualifying individual for a partnership or corporation license, but to qualify for a waiver of examination the following things must all apply.

1) The licensee's individual license must have been active and in good standing for five of the seven years immediately preceding the family member's application for license; 2) The family member must have been actively engaged in the licensee's business for five of the seven years immediately preceding the application for license;

3) The license must be required to continue the existing family business because of the licensee's death or absence, and

4) The new application must be made in the same classification or classifications in which the licensee is or was licensed.

It is important to note that even if all of these conditions exist, a waiver of examination is not automatic. The law allows the Registrar discretionary authority to waive examination in certain circumstances, and the decision is made on the merits of each particular situation.

If a waiver is granted, the Registrar will, as a condition of issuance of the new license, require cancellation of the original licensee's license.

Other circumstances in existing law under which the Registrar may grant a waiver of

To The Industry:

The slow but steady recovery begun in California's construction industry, and continuing improvements in the Contractors State License Board's services, seem to augur well for each of us in 1983.

In saying that, I do not believe I am engaging in the kind of optimism that Voltaire described as, "the mania of maintaining that everything is well when we are wretched." Although neither the building economy nor the effectiveness of CSLB operations may be progressing with the rapidity we might wish, both are experiencing a turn-around that promises to continue.

As construction moves forward, some of the programs begun by the Board in the last couple of years should allow us to respond more effectively to the needs of the industry and the public in general.

One area beginning to show significant results is in application investigation. A study done a year ago showed 18% of the applications we investigated were deliberately falsified. Since that report, an increase in application investigations, consequent license denials, and the policy of citing licensees who sign certifications to false experience claims, has begun to act as a deterrent. Deliberately falsified applications have dropped by over half.

The battle against allowing inexperienced and incompetent contractors into the building trades will always be with us, but for perhaps the first time I feel some real progress in that direction is being made.

Weeding out the "bad apples" already in business is one more facet of that battle, and one which can assume more critical proportions in a depressed economy. During the past year the Board revoked 599 contractors licenses for violation of laws regulating the construction industry—three times as many as in the 1979–80 year.

Also, the first full year of operation of the licensee citation program has resulted in 601 citations being issued. Although a considerable number of the citations issued are appealed, only one was vacated by a hearing judge during 1981/82.

Noncompliance with a citation which is upheld is grounds for suspension or revocation of a contractor's license, and administrative law judges have been taking a tough line in those cases. With further refinements to the citation program, it should prove to be not only a swift means of discipline, but a way of correcting problems as they occur and a deterrent to future violations.

While it is still too early for any clear indication of the effectiveness of the nonlicensee citation program begun last year, we are hoping it will prove to be as effective as the licensee program. One real test will be in previously cited nonlicensees who subsequently apply for license. Not only will any outstanding citations have to be complied with before licenses are issued, but the program gives us a means of triggering application investigations when indicated.



There are approximately 140,000 actively licensed contractors in California at present, and responding to their licensing needs is equally, if not as, important as disciplining the minority who create problems. By streamlining some of our application processes and automating others, we have been able to significantly reduce the waiting time for a license—particularly for those that have an already qualified person and no examination is required. For the most part the licensing process is current. When temporary backlogs do occur, applications required to continue ongoing businesses are given priority.

The Board's goals for this year are to continue improving the Board's services to both ongoing businesses and new licensees, as well as maintaining the forward momentum we have achieved in our regulatory programs. Optimism must be balanced with reality, and the measure of our success will depend at least partially on being allowed necessary resources.

In the next few months we will be doing everything possible within the State's budgetary and legislative processes to assure that CSLB's services keep pace with the construction industry.

- 1) If the person wishing to qualify a license has been a member of the personnel of any license for five of the seven years preceding application. The person's name must have been on CSLB's record of license personnel for the full time. The license must have been active and in good standing, and the new application must be for the same classification as the previous license.
- 2) If the person wishing to qualify is an employee of a corporation applying to replace the corporation's former qualifying individual. That employee must have been continually employed by the corporation in a supervisory capacity, in the same classification's being applied for, for five of the seven years preceding the application. The corporation must also have been actively

NOTICE

A new law and business examination, required for issuance of a contractor's license, will be administered by the Contractors State License Board beginning in March 1983.

The new examination was developed to more accurately reflect the knowledges and tasks important to the success of contractors entering the construction business.

The general content areas and approximate percentage of the test each comprises are: Money Management (28%), Employee Relations (26%) and Contracts and Contract Disputes (46%).

A xeroxed copy of a new Business Management for Contractors booklet is being mailed to all applicants scheduled for examination pending its being available in printed form (at least two to three months). Additional study materials recommended are:

licensed in the same classification/s, and the license must have been in good standing for five of those seven years. "Employee" as used in this context includes, but is not limited to, the officers of a corporation.

Whether or not an applicant desires or thinks he/she is qualified for a waiver of examination, a detail of experience and certifications to that experience are required in the application.

It is not necessary to request a waiver of examination except when a family member is applying because of the death or absence of a licensee. In that case the death or absence must be documented and a request for waiver made based on the documentation.

All other applications which appear to contain circumstances outlined above will be automatically reviewed for a waiver of examination.

HOME IMPROVEMENT

Untangling Salesman Registration Laws

Home improvement salespersons have been required by law to be registered with the Contractors State License Board for several years. Unfortunately, some confusion still seems to exist regarding for whom and in what circumstances registration is needed.

A "home improvement salesman" is defined in the law as a person who is employed by a licensed contractor to "solicit, sell, negotiate or execute" contracts under which home improvements may be performed, a swimming pool constructed, or home improvement goods or services installed or furnished.

Perhaps the first area requiring clarification is what exactly "home improvement" in this context refers to. Broadly defined, home improvement consists of repairs, remodeling, alterations or additions to residential property. Home improvement goods include goods which are to be so affixed that they become a part of the real property (whether or not they can be detached), and would include such items as carpeting and heating and air conditioning equipment. Home improvement services consist of such things as painting, roofing, insulation, etc.

It should be noted that "home improvement salesman" refers to someone soliciting, negotiating or executing contracts for a licensed contractor, and that the definition of a home improvement contract specifies it is in excess of \$500.

Definitions aside, there are other provisions in the law relating to home improvement salespersons, as well as CSLB registration procedures, which create questions. The following are answers to some of the most common ones:

- Q. I am a licensed general building and plumbing contractor and have salesmen working in my shop who not only sell fixtures and equipment, but frequently negotiate remodeling contracts for me. Do they have to be registered as home improvement salesmen?
- A. No. Salespersons who only sell goods or negotiate contracts at a fixed business establishment where the goods or services are exhibited or offered for sale are not considered home improvement salesmen.
- Q. As the RME for a licensed insulation company, I sometimes solicit jobs and execute contracts for the contractor. Should I be registered as a home improvement salesman?
- A. Any of the personnel listed on a contractor's license are exempted from the registration requirement. That includes RMEs, partners, officers of corporations and, of course, individual contractors.
- Q. I am registered as a home improvement salesman for one contractor and also

- want to work for another. Is this possible, and can I use the same registration for both?
- A. A home improvement salesperson can work for any number of contractors and sell a variety of goods or services, but a separate registration number must be obtained for each of the contractors or companies. Each registration will require a separate application and registration fee.
- Q. May I begin working as a home improvement salesman as soon as I have submitted my registration application and fee to the Contractors Board?
- A. No. Before a person is legally registered as a home improvement salesman the application must be reviewed and a registration number issued. The average time required is about two weeks, however, applications submitted with personal or company checks are held until the checks clear which takes approximately five weeks. The Board will accept money orders or certified or cashier's checks.
- Q. If I as a contractor have had a contract sold or negotiated by an unregistered salesman is the contract unenforceable?
- A. The law does not specifically state that the contract would be unenforceable, but as other factors involved could have a bearing on its enforceability, questions on specific contracts should be referred to an attorney. The law does state that a contractor who employs an unregistered person to sell home improvement contracts is subject to disciplinary action by the Contractors State License Board. In addition, it is a misdemeanor for a person to act as a home improvement salesman without being registered.

As a resource for answers to additional questions, the Contractors State License Board has printed a pamphlet titled, "Selected Sections of the Contractors License Law Pertaining to Home Improvement Business and Swimming Pool Construction." Single copies are available free upon request.

The Ins and Outs of Home Improvement Contracts

The business of home improvement constitutes a large portion of California's construction industry. It is also an area easily open to abuse by unlicensed operators, rip-off artists and unethical or incompetent contractors. Although most licensed contractors engaged in the home improvement business do not fall into that category, abuses that do occur reflect negatively on the entire industry.

Recognizing the potential for problems in the home improvement field and the understandable naiveté of many consumers when contracting for home improvements, California's legislature has created laws strictly regulating home improvement contracts. Those laws have been amended and/or strengthened at various times over the past few years and it is important that contractors keep abreast of current requirements.

Existing law requires that any contract for home improvement in excess of \$500, and any change orders to that contract, must be in writing, and the contract must contain the following:


- 1. The name, address and license number of the contractor, and the name and registration number of any salesman who solicited or negotiated the contract.
- 2. The approximate dates when work will begin and be substantially completed, and a definition of what constitutes substantial commencement of the work, i.e., breaking ground, etc.
- 3. A description of the work to be done and the materials and equipment to be used or installed and the agreed upon price.
- 4. A payment schedule showing the amount of each payment in dollars and cents. Each payment must also be specifically referenced to the amount of work to be performed and any materials or equipment to be used or installed. The

down payment may not be in excess of \$1000 or 10% of the contract price (excluding finance charges), whichever is less, and none of the subsequent payments can be for more than the value of work completed or materials and equipment supplied. If the contractor furnishes a payment and performance bond, a lien and completion bond, or a joint control approved by the Registrar, which covers full performance and completion of the contract, the requirements relating to a payment schedule and the down payment no longer apply.

- 5. A notice stating that "failure by the contractor without lawful excuse to substantially commence work within (20) days from the approximate date specified in the contract when work will begin is a violation of the Contractors License Law."
- 6. A notice in at least 10 point type, in close proximity to the signature line, stating that the owner or tenant has the right to require the contractor to have a performance and payment bond.
- 7. A "Notice to Owner" regarding the State's lien laws and the rights and responsibilities of an owner and a contractor. (The language of the notice was included in the Fall/Winter issue of this newsletter.)

In addition, any written contract for which the contractor is the prime contractor must include a notice stating, "Contractors are required by law to be licensed and regulated by the Contractors State License Board. Any questions concerning a contractor may be referred to the registrar of the board whose address is: Contractors State License Board, 3132 Bradshaw Road, Sacramento, California. Mailing Address: P.O. Box 26000, Sacramento, California 95826."

Any contract solicited at some place other than the contractor's place of business, or



"appropriate trade premises", must also contain a notice (in at least 10 point type, in immediate proximity to the signature line) stating, "You, the buyer may cancel this transaction at any time prior to midnight of the third business day after the date of the transaction. See the attached notice of cancellation form for an explanation of this right."

The "Notice of Cancellation" form which must be attached should be available, preprinted, from legal stationery stores or contractors association offices.

The above listing of items that must be included in a home improvement contract is by no means intended to be a listing of everything a contract should contain, only those presently required by law. One obvious ommission is the name and residence address of the homeowner. Other items, such as the legal description of the property, should probably also be included in most cases. However, advice on other items a contract should contain is more appropriately within the purview of an attorney than the CSLB.

Violation of home improvement contract laws is both a misdemeanor and a cause of disciplinary action by the Contractors State License Board.

c) After signing by the contractor and the payee concerned, order for payment together with copies of invoices, unconditional lien releases and/or other substantiating data is delivered or mailed to the Control for payment.

3. Prior to issuing payment, Control agrees to verify:

a) That all vouchers have authorized signatures.

b) That adequate unconditional lien releases have been submitted in writing.

c) That sufficient funds are on hand to pay the specific invoice(s) submitted.

4. Prior to issuing final payment, Control agrees to verify that project has passed final inspection by local building authorities, unless the scope of the contracted project does not require a final inspection.

 After verification of the above, checks shall be made out payable to the supplier or subcontractor, or to the prime contractor and supplier or subcontractor, jointly.

6. Control agrees that in no event shall it disburse payments in excess of 100 percent of the value of the work performed on the

project at any time, excluding finance charges.

 The funds from this account shall be used only for the project described in the contract. Control warrants that work and material paid for by Control has been provided.

8. If this agreement is terminated for any reason prior to disbursement of all monies payable under the contract between Owner and Contractor, all subsequent disbursements to Contractor shall conform to the requirements of Section 7159 of the Business and Professions Code.

NOTE: Section 7159 of the Business and Professions Code requires that all change orders be in writing and signed by all parties.

Contractors who furnish a joint control as part of the terms of a home improvement contract should be aware that the law prohibits them from having any financial or other interest in the joint control company. Also, that it is their responsibility to

determine whether or not the above addendum is included in the control agreement.

If an approved joint control or bond covering the complete contract is not furnished with a home improvement contract, the contractor may not require a down payment in excess of \$1,000 or 10% of the total contract price, whichever is less. The contract must also contain a schedule of payments stated in dollars and cents and specifically referenced to the work or services to be performed or the materials and equipment to be supplied. Also, no payments other than the down payment can be in excess of the value of the work (excluding finance charges) performed at any time on the project.
